BAR-JELLY QUILT

Finished size approximately 135cm x 152cm (53" x 60")

Make this quilt top from just one *Kaffe Fassett Jewels* strip roll (*J2472*), and 1.6m of a toning or contrasting fabric (we used *Aboriginal Dots*, *Sweetpea 1934-14*). You will also require a backing fabric to fit.

For the wadding we recommend Quilters Dream Cotton Natural, Request weight, Twin size (reference *6110*).

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Please read through all the instructions before you begin, all seam allowances are included and are 1/4"

Cutting

7, $3'' \times 60\%''$ for sashing $2\%'' \times 230''$ for binding

Sewing

Remember to press each seam after sewing to achieve the best finish to your work. Press the seams for each vertical strip in opposite directions.

- 1. Unroll the fabrics and sort them into your preferred sequence or pick them at random for a truely scrappy look! Sew the strips together in groups of three.
- 2. Cut each of these strips into 6½" pieces, you should have six from each strip.
- 3. For ease of working stack each set of matching pieces.
- 4. Take the first piece from the top of each stack and sew together along the long edges.
- 5. Repeat until all pieces have been used and you have six strips.
- 6. Place the six strips vertically side by side, the first strip remains as it is.
- 7. On the second strip take the lowest piece (2½" x 6½"); unpick it and sew it at the top of the strip.
- 8. On the third strip take the lowest two pieces and repeat as above.
- 9. Continue in this way taking one more piece each time from the bottom of the strip until all six strips have been worked. The diagram below shows how the sequence of two fabrics should appear after following this method.
- 10. Sew the strips together with a sashing strip between each and one at either side.
- Layer together the quilt top wadding and backing fabric and pin or baste as preferred.
- 12. Quilt all over by hand or machine.
- 13. Add the binding and you're done!
